DEFINITION OF HOME OCCUPATION--An accessory use of a dwelling unit for gainful employment involving the production, provision, or sale of goods and/or services.

Sec. 4211 Home occupations.

(a) Intent--Under certain unique circumstances a small-scaled commercial activity may be an appropriate use within a residential dwelling. The standards and procedure for establishing such uses are intended to limit the scope and nature of such uses and insure compatibility with the adjoining properties.

(b) General standards:

- (1) Home occupations shall be clearly incidental and secondary to the use of the dwelling for residential purposes and shall not change its character as a residence. The use of colors, materials, construction, lighting, or other means inconsistent with a residential use shall be prohibited.
- (2) No equipment or process shall be used in a home occupation which creates noise in excess of 60dB(A) measured at the property line, or vibration, glare, fumes, odors, or electrical interference detectable to the normal senses or impactive to uses off the premises or through common walls. In the case of electrical interference, no equipment or process shall be used which creates interference in any legal cable, broadband, telecommunications, radio or television receivers off the premises or through common walls.
- (3) There shall be no outside storage of goods, products, equipment, or other materials associated with the home occupation, nor shall these materials be stored inside an accessory structure. No toxic, explosive, flammable, radioactive, or other hazardous materials used in conjunction with the home occupation shall be used, sold, or stored on the site.
- (4) The maximum floor area permitted for a home occupation shall be 25% of the finished floor area of the dwelling unit. Storage of goods or products shall not exceed 5% of the finished floor area.
- (5) One person who is not a permanent resident of the dwelling may be engaged or employed in the home occupation.
- (6) The street address of the home occupation may be used in advertisements.
- (7) No sign may be placed on the property advertising the home occupation.
- (8) The type and volume of traffic generated by a home occupation shall be consistent with the traffic generation characteristics of other dwellings in the area. In addition, the lot or property on which the home occupation is conducted shall not have any parking spaces added to it during the time the home occupation is being conducted.
- (9) The home occupation shall not increase demand on water, sewer, or garbage collection services to the extent that the combined demand for the dwelling and home occupation is significantly more than is normal to the use of the property for residential purposes.
